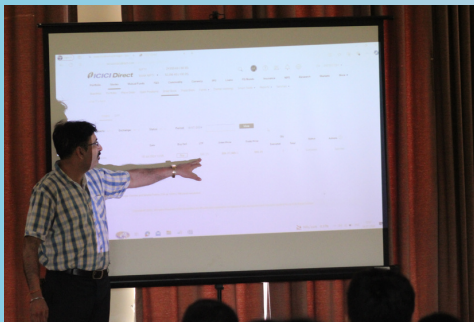


"Join us on an exhilarating journey of discovery at the Regional Science Museum – where our M2-3 explorers dive into the fascinating world of science and innovation!"
