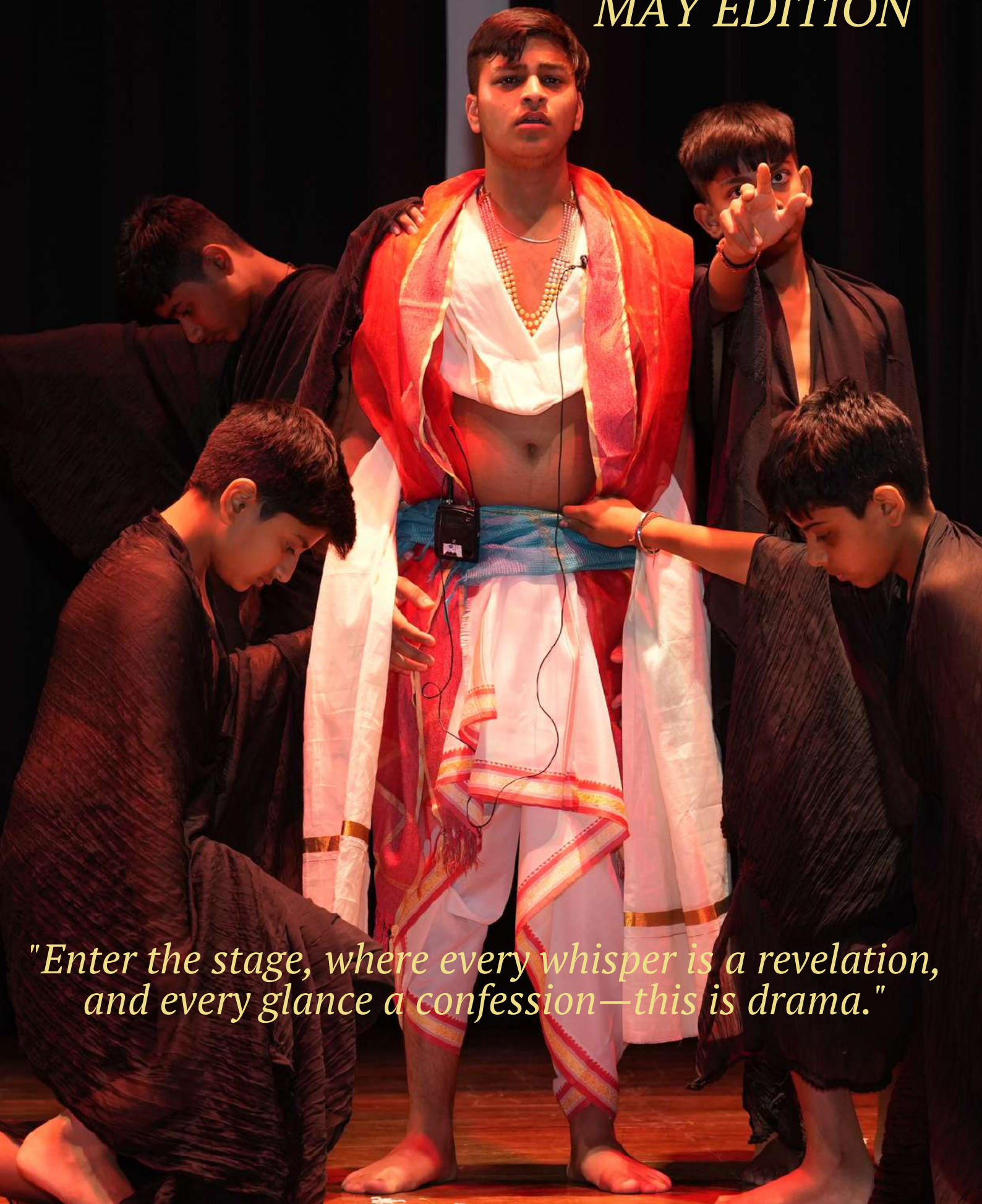

FIELD TRIP TO ONGC MUSEUM

It was a privilege for the students of Grade 9 and 10 to visit the ONGC (Oil and Natural Gas Corporation) Subir Raha Museum, on the 1st of May, 2024. It was an insightful and knowledgeable visit for both; the students, as well as the teachers who accompanied them.

The students walked through a series of rooms and halls, each dedicated to different steps of researching, refining, and transporting crude oil; the thick, viscous, black liquid which holds more importance than gold in today's world and economy. The students learned about what crude oil was, its variety and its by-products, as well as its excavation, the processing it goes through and the tools used to do so. They were given insight on the history of the ONGC, and the history of the discovery of crude oil. There were numerous models of the ships, tools and stations; used to transport, process and excavate crude oil, and interactive displays and experiments for the students to understand complex concepts in a much simpler way.

The fruitful visit concluded with a tour around the ONGC offices, and its engineering marvels.

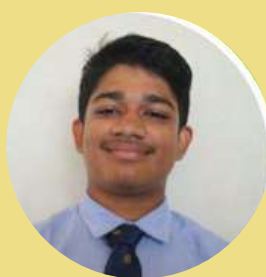

AWARENESS WORKSHOP ON PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL OFFENCES ACT



As an integral part of the school initiative to reinforce awareness on safe learning environment for the children, our school organized comprehensive workshop on sensitive issue of child sexual abuse for academic and administrative staff, where they learnt about Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2012 and its underlying laws. The online workshop which was held on May 11, 2024, was conducted by Ms. Karuna Narang, Freelance Consultant in Child Protection and Former member of CWC and JJB, Delhi. The informative session covered crucial topics like the fundamental rights of children and the importance of identifying and reporting instances of abuse. Ms. Narang explained the features of the POCSO Act which protects all children under-18 years of age. She pointed out that the Act is gender-neutral and elaborated on the different forms of abuse ranging from sexual harassment to pornography to both penetrative and non-penetrative assaults. While sharing a case study, she emphasized how crucial it is to understand how scary and confusing such an experience could be for a child and therefore the matter needed to be handled with utmost sensitivity and delicacy. She also spoke in detail about the prevalence of child abuse in our society and emphasized on the significance of identifying symptoms that might be the cause of behavioural changes in students (regarding mental or physical abuse within the realms of society). She reiterated the importance of the role played by educators in the safety and security of children. As we concluded the workshop, we held a short discussion on some important points of the POCSO Act.

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
