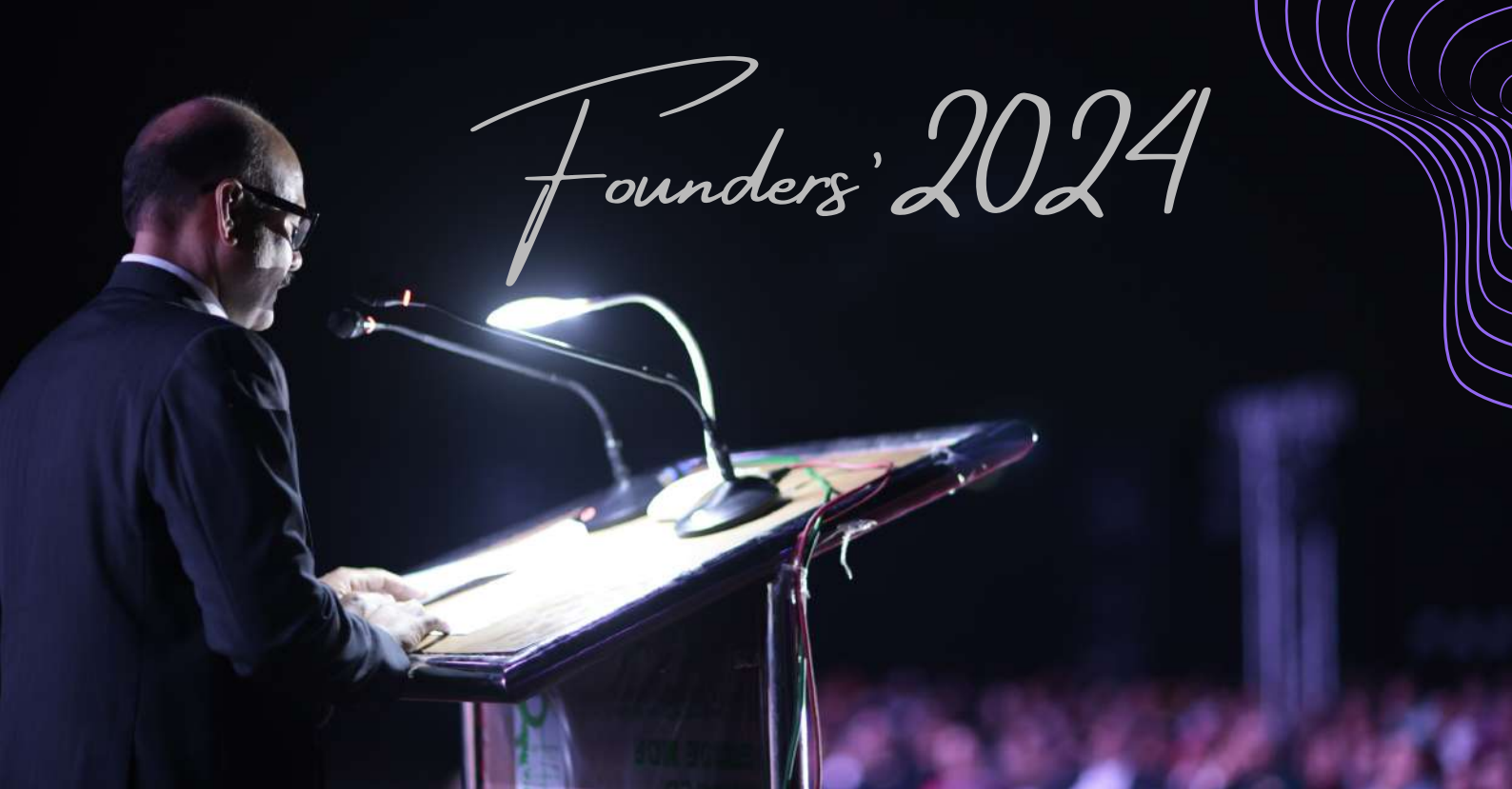

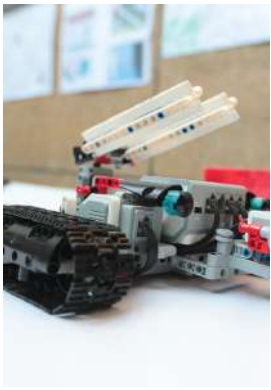


Henry Ford has rightly said, "Coming together is a beginning, keeping together is progress. Working together is success."
