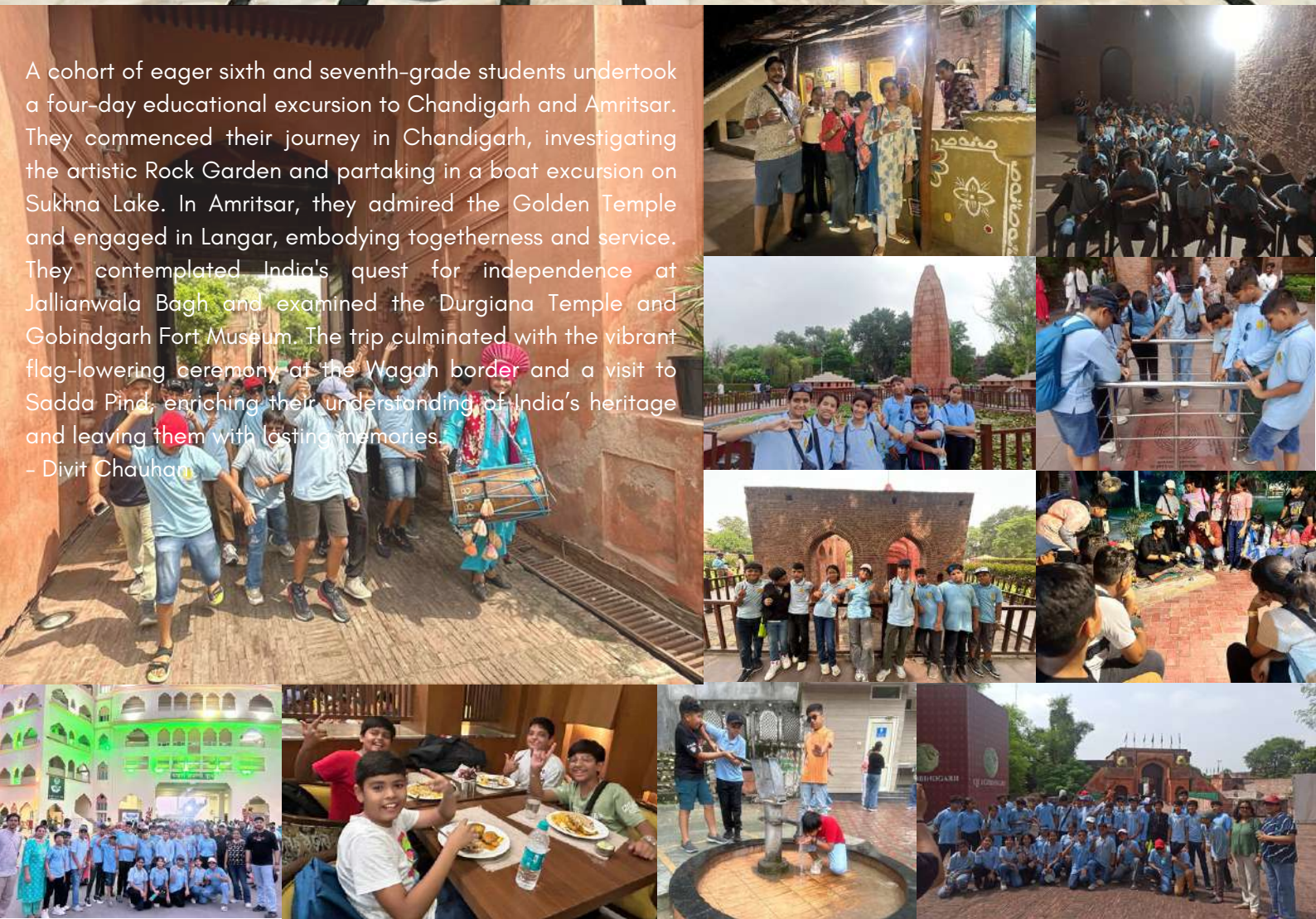


AMRITSAR

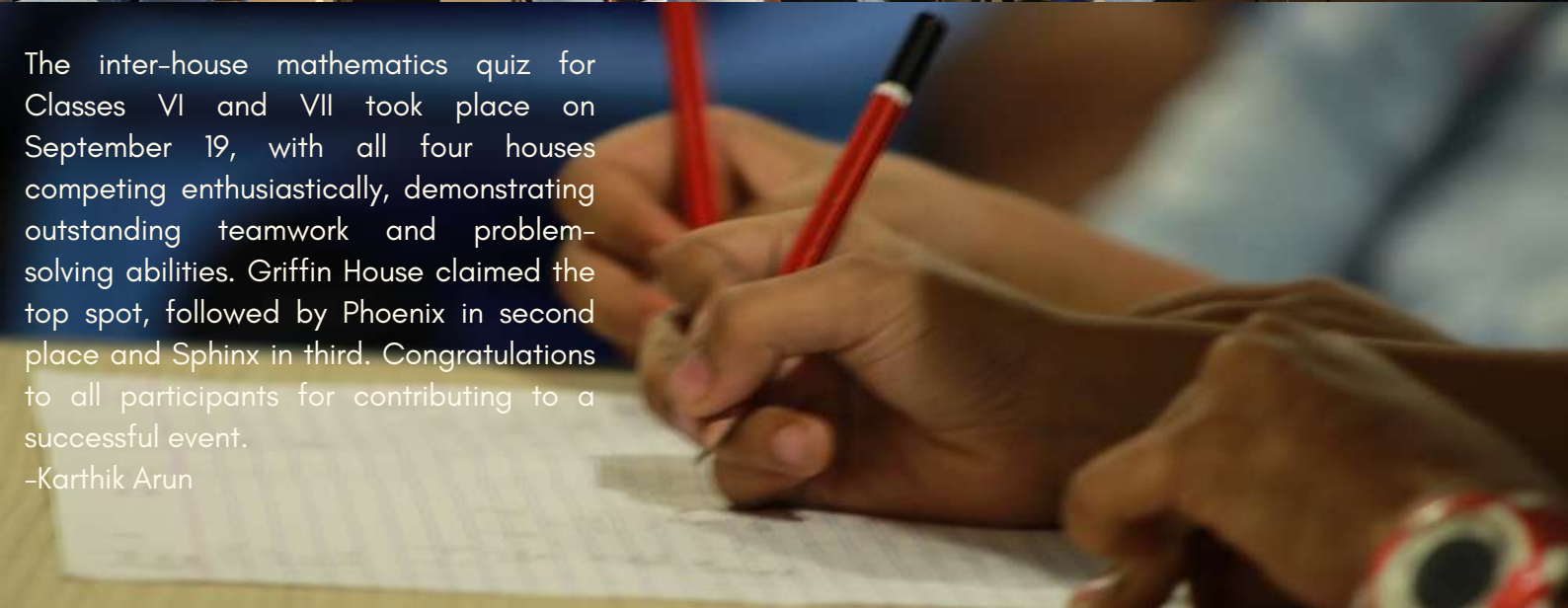


INTER-HOUSE MATHEMATICS QUIZ
