SRCS Shines at the North India Merit School Awards 2025!



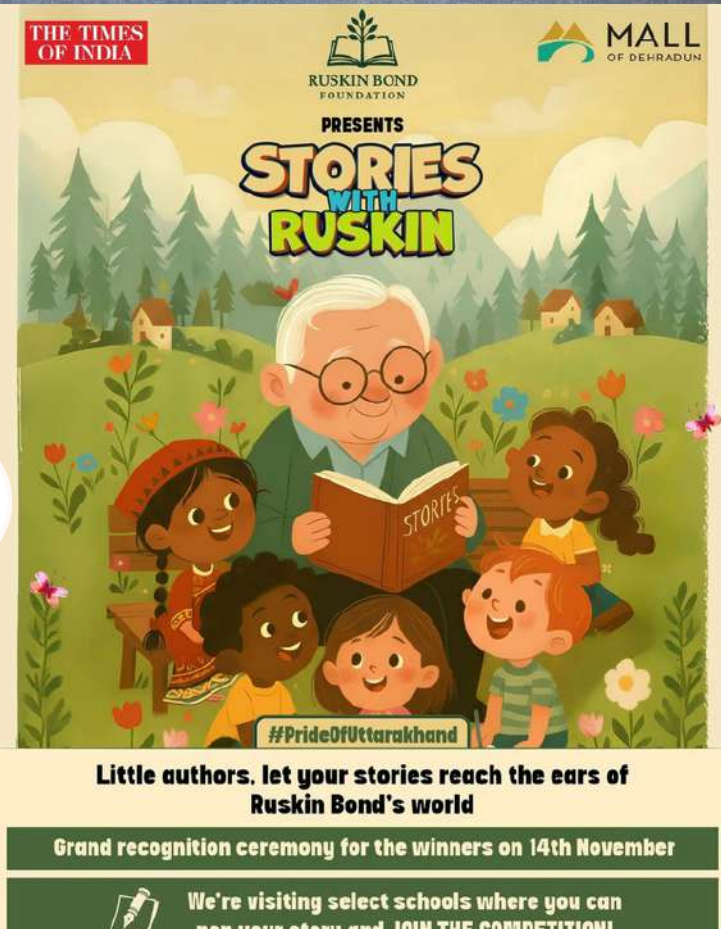
