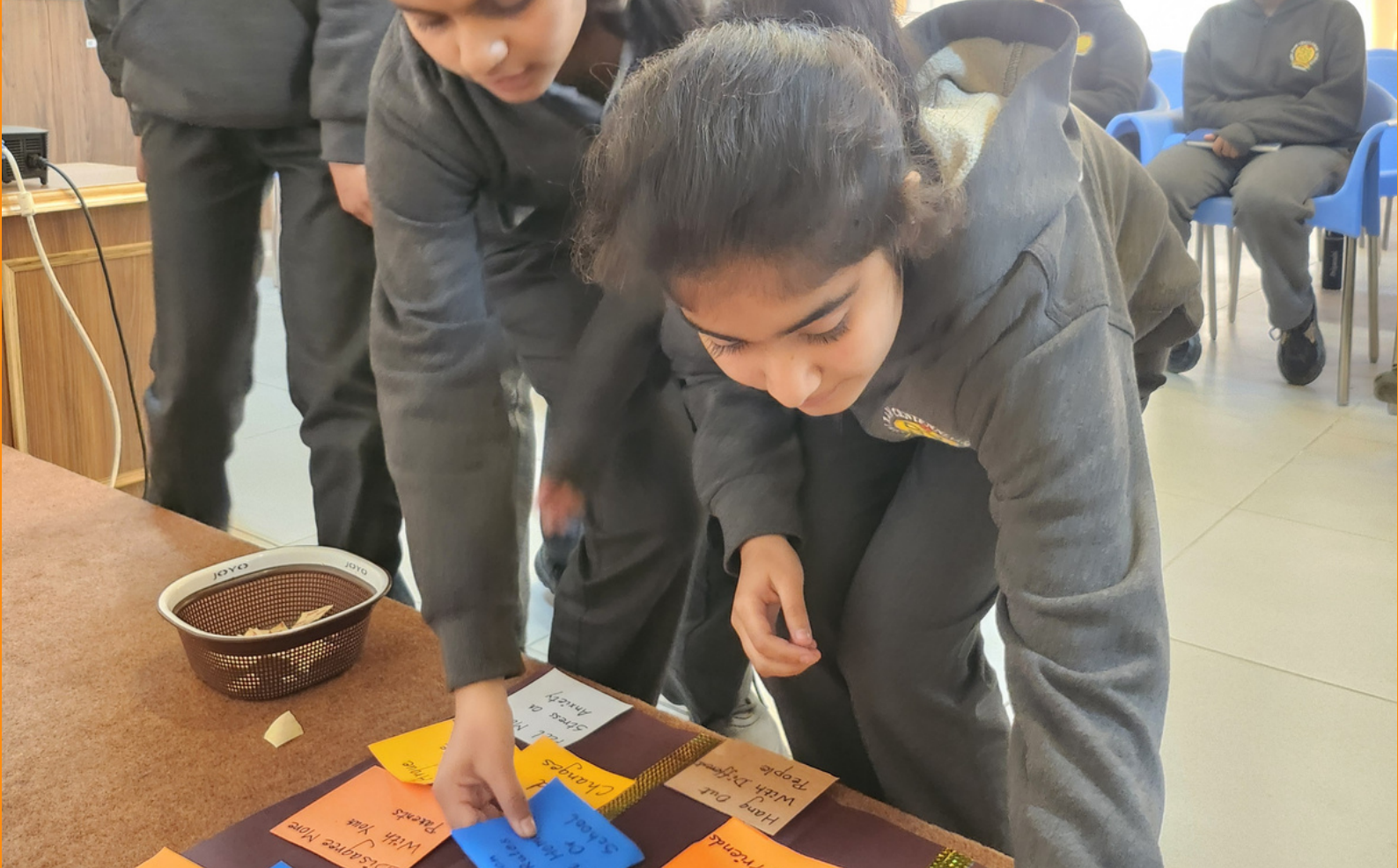
Rainbows Shine at Sports Day 2025!
